**18:32 – Meeting called to order.** Mat motioned, seconded by Greg.

1833, tabled 501c3, John, *KE7GPK* states we are too small, Greg asked how it would benefit us, Zack explained benefits, emails, storage, website; there is lots of paper work and cost would be \$600 to \$900, John makes motion to reject motion, Ron seconds, no objections. Discussion closed.

1837, location for field day booth, Zack scouted and found 11 spots, Greg explained his route on the horse of Pony express, Ron asks if what last year worked ok, Greg states headlights and lights scared horses at night, Greg suggests people set up along the way, group agrees to have check points, Greg suggests a checkpoint every 5-10 miles, Greg and Zack go over route on map showing group, Atlantic City @ 0800 sat, Farson @1400, Green River crossing @ 1600, Granger @ 1730; field day location, John states concern if one is participating in both events, field day will be pretty eliminated, field day booth could act as central hub for communications for Pony Express, Hams can make calls to base camp, Greg explains pony express to new guests, back to discussing field day location.

1915 - Primary spot, shows on map as Union Pacific property, Isaac will reach out and ask permission, if we can then well go out and see if location would work okay, Greg says ask mayor if there would be a suggestion if there is another.

1918 - space port days, Zack explained event, Greg - city should have a PA system but no power, Greg has generator, Zack and Greg will look at it later.

1920- discussing training schedule, Saturday May 25 hf ant with Ron, Fox Hunt Zak *KJ7ZTE* can lead fox hunt and antenna building, test and class in November Ron and Bob can teach, Christmas party Jan 11<sup>th</sup>.

1943 - New business, letter for Pony express and donations, Robbie - club was a lot bigger back then, have nets on DMR and simplex, suggested having Newsline rebroadcasted on net, no opposed to letters being sent out,

1956 – Field Day QSO cards and shirts, Lois will put together order, Greg has a lot of old QSO cards so we won't need to buy new ones.

2003- Field Day volunteers and positions, Isaac volunteered for safety officer tentative to getting off of work that day, Greg volunteered for the education position.

2008 - [Zack](#) goes over event this month.

2011 - Call for round table discussion, Bob - John Loyd (repeater) said the Buffalo Hump repeater would be ready in a week or two.

Next meeting June 11th in Rock Springs.

2014, John motion for adjournment, Greg second. **Meeting was adjourned.**
